

SAMPLE MATERIAL: 24-HOUR URINE COLLECTION IN ACIDIFIED CONTAINER

List of tests to be carried out on acidified urine:

- Fractionated catecholamines
- 5-hydroxyindoleacetic acid
- vanillylmandelic acid
- metanephrines

Samples Collection

- Obtain a 24-hour urine collection container directly from the collection room of the Laboratory analysis center.
- CAUTION: THE CONTAINER CONTAINS HYDROCLORIDIC ACID. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
 Hydrochloridric acid is corrosive and, if it comes in contact with the skin it causes burns; if inhaled it
 causes irritation to the respiratory tract; if brought in contact with eyes it causes serious eye
 damage
- **Note:** When testing for 5-hydroxyindoleacetic acid, vanillylmandelic acid and metanephrines it is necessary to follow a diet free of bananas, vanilla, chocolate, coffee, tea, pineapple, kiwi and walnuts, starting 48 hours prior and for the entire duration of urine collection.
- Throw away the first morning urine
- From that moment for the next 24 hours collect urine (from the second urination to the first
 urination the following morning): pee in a paper cup and then pour it into the container; absolutely
 DO NOT pee directly in the container
- During the urine collection keep the canister in a cool place throughout the day.
- When collection is complete, note the volume of the entire collection, patient's surname, first name and date of birth on the canister
- Note: it is very mportant that all 24-hour urine is collected

Samples Delivery

- Check the opening hours of your chosen laboratory analysis center
- Register at the counters at the Administrative Reception desk
- Deliver the canister to the health personnel in the collection room: be sure volume of the entire collection, patient's surname, first name and date of birth are noted on the bin.
