

24-HOUR URINE SAMPLE COLLECTION PROCEDURE

To: Mr./Mrs.

Please be informed that the correct procedure for collecting a 24-hour urine sample is as follows:

- ✓ procure a container for collecting a 24-hour urine sample: these containers normally hold 2.5 L of urine, procure a second container if you think you'll need it;
- ✓ discard the first morning urine;
- ✓ start collecting urine directly in the container from the second urination up to the first urination of the following morning;
- \checkmark keep the container during the day in a cool place;
- having completed the collection, indicate the total volume of urine collected on the container: it is very important to collect all the urine passed during the 24 hours
- ✓ on the same day on which you finish collecting the urine, go to the Central Reception desk to register and then **deliver the container**, duly marked with the total volume of urine collected (see previous point) and the patient's full name and date of birth, to the Sample Collection Room.
